- Hector stated the trash receptacle had a leak and has been repaired.
- All liquid products (milk) are disposed down the sink before throwing the bottle away.
- Advised manager to double bag all food products that are to be thrown away.
- Observed trash enclosure in satisfactory condition.
- Facility steam cleans enclosure once a week (Tuesdays).
