Violation: OTHER PERMIT VIOLATION

Description/Corrective Action: The facility currently does not have an active food vending permit, and has been operating with an expired permit since November of 2011. In order to continue to operate, you must remit all pending fees by no later than 5:00 PM today. Failure to respond will result in closure of the facility by 2/10/11.

General Comments:

Today's re-inspection was to verify that the pest infestation has been eliminated. No pest activity was noted today. The maintenance of the kitchen has greatly improved since the last inspection. Please continue to maintain a daily cleaning schedule and continue to provide routine pest control services to keep pests away.

Although necessary improvements were confirmed, the facility was found to be operating with an expired permit since November 2011. The fees must be paid by 5:00 PM today to avoid closure. Please contact our office if you have any questions.

Violation: IMPROPER MAINTENANCE OF FACILITY OR EQUIPMENT [HSC 114161-114182 & 114257]

Description/Corrective Action: The equipment surfaces were observed clean; however deep cleaning requires that you pull out the cook top and grill to clean behind, beneath and around them. Remove all visible food debris and grease build-up from these areas on a routine basis. Use sealant or caulking material to seal off any gaps or openings around counters, walls and floors to deny further pest entry.

Violation: FOODS & EQUIPMENT NOT PROTECTED FROM CONTAMINATION [HSC 113980, 114025-114027]

Description/Corrective Action: Use 10% bleach and water solution to place cleaning rags and do frequent cleaning of all food contact surfaces, especially areas where roach activity may be seen. Plates, cups and silverware needs to go through the dishwasher at the start of the day to make sure they are clean and sanitized before they are used. A dead roach was observed on top of a plate. Preferably, cover the dishware before closing the facility.

General Comments:

Pest control services were provided on 1/21/12 by San Joaquin PC as requested. The facility has signed a 2 year contract for continued service. At this time, there is minimal pest activity and the operator is cooperatively following the guidelines mentioned to help eliminate the problem. You must maintain a daily cleaning schedule to minimize any further pest infestations. A re-inspection will be done on or after 2/10/12 to verify that the problem has been eliminated.

Violation: VERMIN INFESTATION [HSC 114259.1]

Description/Corrective Action: Roaches (nymphs and adults) were visible throughout the kitchen. The complaint filed with the Department has been validated. Pest control services are required immediately or the facility should temporarily close until services can be provided.

Violation: IMPROPER EXCLUSION OF VERMIN OR ANIMALS [HSC 114259-114259.3]

Description/Corrective Action: Facility currently does not provide pest control services. San Joaquin PC was contacted and is scheduled to provide service on Saturday, 1/21/12. Services are needed immediately or by no later than 1/21/12..

Violation: FOODS & EQUIPMENT NOT PROTECTED FROM CONTAMINATION [HSC 113980, 114025-114027]

Description/Corrective Action: Observed equipment soiled with grease and food debris accumulation. The present condition promotes the harborage of pests and needs to be corrected as soon as possible.

General Comments:

A complaint was filed with the Department alleging the presence of roaches on the dining room tables. Today's inspection confirmed these allegations.

A re-inspection has been scheduled for Monday 1/23/12, at which time you must provide proof of pest control service receipts for services provided no later than 1/21/12, and complete cleaning of the kitchen equipment must be done.
