Today's inspection was prompted by a complaint alleging the restrooms are unsanitary.

During the complaint inspection of the restroom the following was noted: Mens restrooms lack Hot water, Please provide Hot water to mens restroom.

Womens restroom was said to have Hot water; However, Hot water was not noted during today's inspection. Please provide Hot Water. Operator stated customers clean the restrooms, and restrooms are cleaned or checked Every 20 mins: 30 mins.

A Routine inspection of the refrigeration area revealed the following.

Refrigeration unit measured at 53°F (ambient air) Hot Dogs were probed, they measured at 47°F. All PHF's must be maintained at 41°F. ~~smk~~ Hot had Hot water.

All foods served are either prepackaged, Frozen, or out of the can (eg canned chili, choco. milk).

AT This Time the complaint is Valid. Restrooms must have Hot water for handwashing, please repair within two weeks, a re-inspection will be conducted.
