1. Staff reports and recommendations on the proposed project Conditional Use Permit No. 05-10, a proposal to continue disposal capacity for designated and hazardous solid waste at the Kettleman Hills Facility (KHF), which is owned and operated by CWMI. The project involves the expansion, continued operation and closure of the existing Class I/II B-18 Landfill and construction and operation, and closure of a new Class I/II B-20 Landfill. The project site is located at 35251 Old Skyline Road, approximately 3 ½ miles west of Kettleman City, Assessor's Parcel Numbers: 038-310-005; 038-320-015, 020, and 021; and 038-330-001, 019, and 020.
