



KINGS COUNTY APPLICATION FOR ELECTION OFFICERS

The Kings County Elections Office maintains a list of people who have expressed an interest in working as an Election Officer. Election Officers are needed at various times throughout the year, depending on the election schedule.

*Workdays begin at **6:00 a.m.** and end around **10:00 p.m.** All first time Election Officers are required to attend a training class that lasts about three hours.*

Clerks are paid \$98.00 per day and Inspectors are paid \$125.00 per day. The Elections Department is looking for people who are helpful, conscientious, and friendly. Additionally, there is a great need for Election Officers who can provide bilingual assistance to Spanish speaking voters. You must be at least eighteen years of age, a United States citizen, California resident, and a registered voter. Persons who are on parole for the conviction of a felony may not serve as an Election Official. By law all precinct workers are required to be able to read and write in English.
