**RESOLUTION NO. 06-18  
RE: 2007 FTIP  
AMENDMENT NO. 2**

**WHEREAS**, the Kings County Association of Governments is a Regional Transportation Planning Agency and a Metropolitan Planning Organization, pursuant to State and Federal designation; and

**WHEREAS**, KCAG prepared and adopted the 2006-2007 through 2008-09 Federal Transportation Improvement Program (FTIP) and related Air Quality Conformity Determination on July 19, 2006 to comply with Federal and State requirements for local projects and is consistent with the Regional Transportation Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, Amendment No. 2 to the Kings County FTIP amends the *Safety* element as follows:

Caltrans:

1. Hazard Elimination Safety - Lump Sum  
Add lump sum for new project
2. Section 130 Grade Crossing Protection Projects - Lump Sum  
Add lump sum for new project

**WHEREAS**, this amendment was prepared through a cooperative process between the Federal Department of Transportation, the California Department of Transportation, principal elected officials of general purpose local governments and their staffs, and public owned operators of mass transportation services acting through the KCAG forum and general public involvement; and

**WHEREAS**, the Federal Highway Administration has provided guidance that projects submitted in the FTIP be demonstrated as reasonable requests when compared to available funding and Caltrans can affirm that funding is available; and

**WHEREAS**, the projects contained in this amendment do not require a re-determination of the air quality conformity analysis.

**WHEREAS**, the amendment was circulated for public review and comment, with a public hearing held on October 25, 2006.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Kings County Association of Governments, Transportation Policy Committee does hereby approve Amendment No. 2 to the 2007 Federal Transportation Improvement Program, as shown in "Attachment 1".




