

COMMUNITY CANVASSING

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

This project is designed to educate you and your peers on the negative influences impacting your community.

You will be trained on procedures to locate and report unsafe or hazardous areas within 1,000 feet of your school site. Findings will include:

- number of alcohol outlets;
- amount of alcohol/tobacco advertising;
- unsafe parks/playgrounds;
- areas of drug sales and gang activity;
- billboard/bus shelter/bench advertisements.

All of these factors may influence individual decisions to use alcohol and/or tobacco. After surveying your community, you will have the opportunity to submit your findings to public/city officials.

Coordination of the surveying will take place in your local community area. This is your opportunity to be an advocate for your community.
