VII. ADJOURNMENT

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NOTICE OF RIGHT TO APPEAL:

- A. For projects where the Planning Commission's action is final, actions are subject to appeal by the applicant or any other directly affected person or party and no development proposed by the application may be authorized until the final date of the appeal period. An appeal may be filed with the Planning Department at 1400 W. Lacey Blvd., Building #6, Hanford, CA, on forms available at the Planning Department. A filing fee of \$220.00 must accompany the appeal form. The appeal must be filed within 8 days of the Planning Commission's decision date, not including the date of the decision. If no appeal is received, the Planning Commission's action is final. There is no right of appeal for projects for which the Planning Commission's action is advisory to the Board of Supervisors.**
- B. For projects where the Advisory Agency's action is final, actions are subject to appeal by any interested person and no development proposed by the application may be authorized until the final date of the appeal. An appeal may be filed with the Planning Department at 1400 W. Lacey Blvd., Building #6, Hanford, CA, on forms available at the Planning Department. A filing fee of \$220.00 must accompany the appeal form. The appeal must be filed within 10 days of the Advisory Agency's decision date, not including the date of the decision. If no appeal is received, the Advisory Agency's action is final.**
