

ARTICLE 3. ZONING PLAN

Sec. 301. Adoption of zoning plan.

In order that comprehensive zoning regulations may be uniformly applied to all unincorporated territory with the adoption of this Ordinance, Map No. 301 is on file in the planning office and made a part of this Ordinance by reference with the same force and effect as if the boundaries, together with any notations, references and information shown on said map were specifically set out and described in this Ordinance. Said map hereby adopted and made a part of this Ordinance is Map No. 301, dated March 2nd, 1964, Kings County Zone Plan.

Sec. 302. District maps.

District maps shall be adopted in the manner provided for changing district boundaries as prescribed in Article 23 of this Ordinance. Said adoption shall be recognized by the addition to this article of the ordinance section by adopting said map and the filing of said map, properly attested, in the planning office. A district map shall be identified by a number corresponding to the number of the ordinance section of this article adopting the district map. District maps shall commence with number 302.
