1. If you have a food, housing or medical benefits emergency, please call **852-2235** or toll free **1-800-289-9981, extension 2235** between the hours of 9:00 AM and 3:00 PM. Your call will be screened for an emergency and you may be seen by a worker by appointment only in the Human Services Agency Hanford office.
2. You can file an application for assistance by picking up an application from the box located near the front door of the Human Service Agency Hanford office, or at the Corcoran Police Department, or at the Avenal City Office.
